



## NEW INFORMATION ON SUMMERDAZE—NEW PRICING!!

### What is Summer Daze

Summer Daze is a day of service, which also includes prayer and social activities with other youth from parishes throughout the New Albany Deanery. (Please see schedule attached.)

### General Information:

- Participants are incoming 6, 7, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students.
- Summer Daze begins at 8:30am and concludes at 4:30pm. (See transportation info below.)
- Several of our social events will require additional waivers from parents. They will be emailed to you next week, once we receive them.
- Youth may not wear flip-flops or sandals of any kind. Tennis shoes with socks are required at the work sites and at the social events.
- Please remind youth to wear clothes appropriate for working. Our sites will include landscaping, painting, cleaning, etc. Old clothes are the best option!
- All materials, safety gear, and tools will be provided at the work sites.
- A Summer Daze Tshirt will be offered for all participants (Youth sizes S-L and adult sizes S-XXL). The Tshirt will be passed out on the first day of service work, unless early-pick-up arrangements are made with the Catalyst Office ahead of time.

### For Deanery Group w/o Leaders (Holy Family has no Youth Minister/Leader) :

- Youth joining the deanery group will make their payment directly to Catalyst Catholic.

  - June 4 social: \$8.00 per youth / \$10.00 per adult
  - June 11 social: \$13.00 per person
  - June 18 social: \$5.00 per person
  - June 25 social: \$9.00 per person
- Deanery group members will need to be dropped off at our Mt. St. Francis office at 8:30am on Summer Daze dates and will be the responsibility of the Catalyst staff and volunteers during the day, including transportation.

When all groups arrive at Indiana Caverns, the youth may choose/be divided into group of 20. Each group will be given a 90-minute underground cave tour and boat ride. Tours will be dismissed in 15-minute intervals 1pm until 2:30pm, as needed. While waiting, groups may explore the nature trail, interpretive trail, gift shop, etc. Likewise, when a group's cave tour is completed, the group may explore the other venues within the park. (Cost per person: \$8.00 youth / \$10.00 adult)
